The native code of the ODERU is Open Source under the Apache License, Version 2. You may obtain a copy of this license at <http://www.apache.org/licenses/LICENSE-2.0>.

Nevertheless, the full ODERU source code makes use of the Java constraint programming solver JaCoP, which code is released under GNU Affero General Public License (AGPL) Version 3 by the core developers of JaCoP who are the JaCoP code copyright holders. You may obtain a copy of this license at <http://www.gnu.org/licenses/agpl-3.0.en.html>. If ODERU with JaCoP is used for commercial purposes the JaCoP code can be released by the copyright holders of JaCoP under different license schemes: <https://osolpro.atlassian.net/wiki/display/JACOP/JaCoP+Licence>
